As Thanksgiving approaches, we are reminded that the gardening season will soon come to a close – *and what a fantastic year we have had!* Now is the time to wrap up loose ends and put things to bed before the cold of winter arrives. In the coming weeks we can look forward to:



- ◆ **Tulip Planting** – continuing to layout bulbs, plant tulips, net, and hoop beds! We are currently over half done!
- ◆ **Lighting Garden Hoops for FOL** – before Festival of Lights begins, we will light the hoops and canes that we use for garden borders with holiday lights.
- ◆ **Adding greens to Food Wall & FOL Containers** – adding a little holiday flair!
- ◆ **Fall Garden Maintenance** – light leaf removal and cutting back grasses and perennials in low profile areas to get ahead of the spring rush.
- ◆ **Potting up Elephant Ears at Fidelity** – after bulbs we will head to the Fidelity Greenhouse to finish processing and potting up our elephant ears. They will remain dormant throughout the winter and we will begin growing them in late February for Summer Displays.
- ◆ **Nursery winterization** – we will finalize our nursery winterization to make sure that the plants are snug throughout the chilly winter months.
